For Ros Harman, who was diagnosed with multiple sclerosis more than 30 years ago, and regularly attends the MSWA's Outreach Program, Wilson is her home away from home.

"It's great to have everything I need under the one roof, and I'm always greeted with a welcoming smile by Janet at reception. I have regular physiotherapy sessions with Sharon and Ben who help to retain my physical mobility and independence, and occupational therapists are also available at Wilson if I need them," said Ros.

"I know my NDIS plan will cover my services, but it's all the extras, like the outstanding facilities, new equipment and the caring staff that add to the experience I enjoy at MSWA."

MSWA is Western Australia's leading provider of neurological services and a registered NDIS provider. MSWA's General Manager – Member Services, Sue Shapland said that for many people with neurological conditions, putting an NDIS plan in place can be daunting.

"The area around hydrotherapy pool – a long-time favourite feature of the Wilson facility for many of our customers, has also been refurbished. And there's extra off-road parking for visitors and more workstations for our rapidly growing workforce."
